
Greensboro Council voted for:

- 1. A containment and cover system, and stream restoration at Bingham Park, for
 - \circ Area #1 & Area #2 (the park portion of the project) and
- 2. A <u>full remediation at the former Hampton School</u> site across the street from the park (where a park will be developed on a portion of that land).
 - Area #3 & Area #4, across the street

The cost is estimated at \$12.4 million / Total funding available: \$18.05M


The City will authorize allocating \$10 million of the funds received for remediation from State House Bill 259 to support this project.


\$7 million is available from the NC Department of Environmental Quality, and \$1.05 million from a Federal Appropriations Bill.
